**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
SUPPORTING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS BY CALTRANS ON THE EXISTING
CROSS WALK ON METZ ROAD NEAR SAN VICENTE SCHOOL AND IMPOSING A
“NO-STOPPING ANY TIME” RESTRICTION ON A PORTION OF METZ ROAD**

WHEREAS, CalTrans staff met with school officials and City Staff in the summer of 2006 to discuss safety improvements to the existing cross walk on Metz Road; and

WHEREAS, CalTrans staff has prepared proposed school crossing improvements and asked the City to support the proposed improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council reviewed the proposed improvements at the meeting of April 4, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is interested in receiving input from the parties who would be affected by the proposed improvements, such as the Soledad Unified School District, adjacent property owners and residents and parents of school students; and

WHEREAS, the City has notified the Soledad Unified School District, affected property owners and residents by mail and invited them to provide comments and input on the proposed improvements at the City Council meeting of April 18, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received a letter of support from the Soledad Unified School District on the proposed improvements; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby **RESOLVE** as follows:

Section 1. The City Council supports the school crossing improvements on Metz Road proposed by Caltrans.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the imposition of a “no parking anytime” restriction on a portion of Metz Road as shown on the proposed improvement plan. In connection with the designation of a “no-stopping any time” area, the City Council directs the Public Works Staff to paint the curb red and install “no-stopping any time” signs along the designated portion of Metz Road.


