

RESOLUTION NO. 3983

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSULTING SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH THE EDCCO GROUP FOR THE DESIGN OF A NEW SCADA
SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,673**

WHEREAS, given that it is necessary to design a new SCADA system identified in the 2005 Water Master Plan, Staff issued a request for proposals to firms experienced in the development of such plans with a closing date for responses set for April 9, 2007; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received from the following six companies: Black & Veath, Consipio, Cybernet Consulting, Lee & Ro, The EDCCO Group, and Viking Services; and

WHEREAS, the five submittals were reviewed by the Public Works Director and the firms were evaluated by an interview panel on the experience, quality and content of the submittal and cost of service. Based on the experience, quality and content of the submittals and the cost of service, it has been determined that The EDCCO Group is best suited to meet the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, The EDCCO Group is experienced in designing SCADA systems for other public agencies; and

WHEREAS, in the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 budget, the City allocated \$300,000 for the design and construction of a new water SCADA system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a Consulting Services Agreement with The EDCCO Group for the design of a new water SCADA system in an amount not to exceed \$40,673.


