

RESOLUTION NO. 4028

**A RESOLUTION FROM THE SOLEDAD CITY COUNCIL DECLARING
"REPLACED" POLICE VEHICLE #55 AS SURPLUS EQUIPMENT AND
AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF SUCH PROPERTY TO THE MONTEREY
PENINSULA COLLEGE POLICE ACADEMY**

WHEREAS, Government State Code Section 37350 provides for the ability of cities to dispose of property for the common benefit of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad has accumulated material that has been deemed surplus property; and

WHEREAS, Staff believes that the City Council may declare "replaced" police vehicle #55 from the Soledad Police Department as surplus property, and is recommending that the same be donated to the Monterey Peninsula College Police Academy; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey Peninsula College Police Academy benefit from the donation of equipment it would not otherwise be able to afford and the City of Soledad benefits from the overall improvement of Monterey Peninsula College Police Academy graduates.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby declare Soledad Police Vehicle #55 as surplus property and authorizes the City Manager to donate the vehicles to the Monterey Peninsula Police Academy.
