

RESOLUTION NO. 4034

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SOLEDAD APPROVING THE SOLEDAD HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S
REQUEST TO PLACE A MARKER NEAR THE OLD TRAIN DEPOT SITE**

WHEREAS, the Soledad Historical Society requests placement of a bronze marker at the edge of Caesar Chavez park, to commemorate the 13 years that Soledad was the end of the line for the South Pacific Railroad line that originated from the north; and

WHEREAS, the 12 x 12 bronze marker will read as follows and will be placed on a boulder: RAILROAD STATION SITE - Southern Pacific railroad reached Soledad in 1873. Until 1886, Soledad was the transportation hub of the Southern Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, the boulder will be placed near the original depot station at the edge of Caesar Chavez Park located on Front Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Soledad hereby approves the Soledad Historical Society's request to place a marker near the old train depot station.




