**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF AN ALL-WAY STOP CONTROL  
AT THE INTERSECTION OF INCA DRIVE AND AZTLAN CIRCLE**

**WHEREAS**, staff presents two options to improve the visibility and safety problems at the intersection of Inca Drive and Aztlan Circle.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Soledad Authorizes the Placement of an "All-Way Stop Control" at the intersection of Inca Drive and Aztlan Circle.





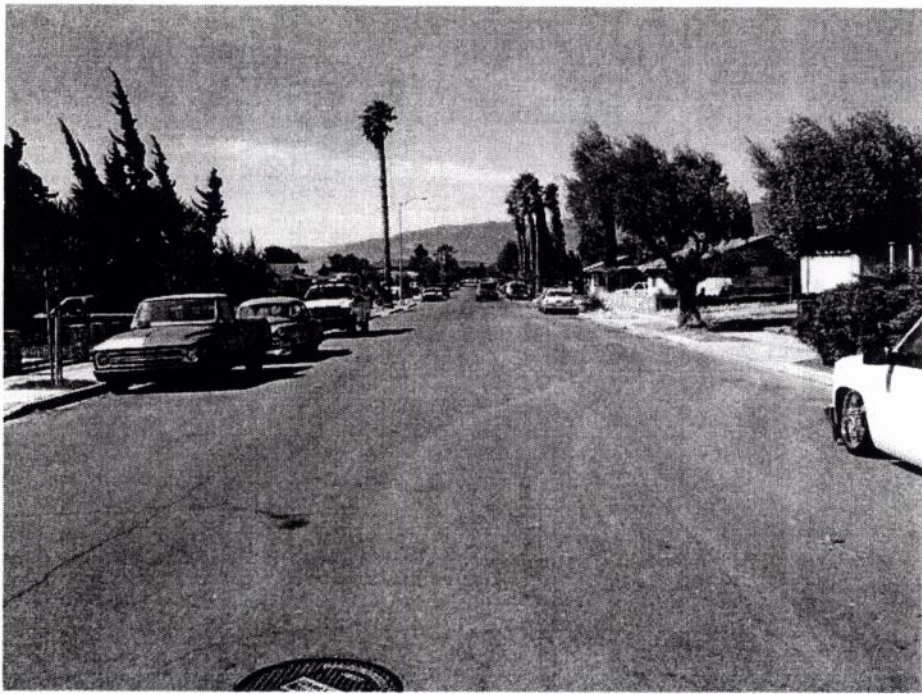
