

RESOLUTION NO. 4113

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE SOLEDAD LIONS' REQUEST FOR USE OF THE COMMUNITY
CENTER FOR A COMMUNITYWIDE THANKSGIVING LUNCHEON AND
AUTHORIZING SPONSORSHIP OF THE EVENT**

WHEREAS, in January of 2005, the City Council approved an additional five-year Management Agreement with the YMCA to oversee programs and maintenance of the Soledad Community Center; and

WHEREAS, based on the new Agreement, the City of Soledad has unlimited use of the Center for City and City sponsored events and up to fifty (50) hours for Non-City sponsored events; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad Lions has requested use of the Community Center for a period of up to eleven (11) hours to hold a Thanksgiving Luncheon for the community to be held on Thursday, November 22, 2007; and

WHEREAS, to date the City has used fourteen (14) hours of its fifty non-sponsored discretionary hours with a remaining thirty-six (36) hours remaining to be allocated by December 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, if the Council approved use of City hours under this provision in the amount requested, the City will have twenty-five (25) hours available for the remainder of the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that the event is of benefit to the City of Soledad since the event will help to commemorate the spirit of the holiday and is open to all the residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad does hereby **sponsor** the Soledad Lions' request for use of the Community Center for its Thanksgiving Luncheon.




