

RESOLUTION NO. 4117

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD ADOPTING
THE CITY OF SOLEDAD EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the current Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) for the City of Soledad is out of date and does not comply with the National Incident Management System; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest for the residents of Soledad, that the City of Soledad adopt and implement an updated EOP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad hired Harry Robbins to revise the EOP; and

WHEREAS, Staff has reviewed the revised EOP and recommended changes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Soledad has reviewed the EOP and made recommendations; and

WHEREAS, a final version of EOP, incorporating Staff and Council recommendations and including a timeline for a proposed implementation plan, has now been completed and submitted for Council review and approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the Council adopts the revised Emergency Operations Plan of the City of Soledad, and directs Staff to initiate action to carry out the implementation plan contained within the EOP.


