

RESOLUTION NO. 4138

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A REQUEST TO CALTRANS
TO RELINQUISH STATE ROUTE 146 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the relinquishment of a portion of a State highway is provided in Section 73 and 73.5 of the California Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, the relinquishment process is further described in detail in Chapter 25 of the Caltrans Project Development Procedures Manual; and

WHEREAS, the benefit to the City in obtaining the ownership of SR 146 within the City limits is that the City will be in charge of the administration, planning, construction and operation of this segment of SR 146 without the need for obtaining encroachment permits or approval from Caltrans.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a request to Caltrans to relinquish State Route 146 within the City limits.


