

**RESOLUTION NO. 4160**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
APPROVING THE SECOND CYCLE OF GRANT FUNDING FOR NON-PROFIT  
AGENCIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007-08 PURSUANT TO CITY POLICY NO. 480**

**WHEREAS**, City Policy No. 480, adopted by the City Council on June 7, 2000, and amended several times thereafter, established the process by which non-profit organizations may request and the City may grant funds for programs or activities which benefit the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council appropriated \$23,500 in the Fiscal Year 2007-08 Budget for City Council Non-Profit Grants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City duly complied with the provisions of Policy No. 480 by advertising and otherwise notifying non-profit entities of the availability of such funding grants; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 28, 2008, a subcommittee consisting of two Council members reviewed all applications and made recommendations with respect to appropriate grant awards; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council now wishes to act on said recommendations.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows:

1. The City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of and adopts the recommendation of the City Council Grant Subcommittee for Grants in Fiscal Year 2007-08 totaling \$ 4,100 and authorizes the following grant awards to the entities and in the amounts hereafter indicated:

Food Bank for Monterey County	\$ 2,100
Alliance on Aging	\$ 1,000
Center for Employment Training	\$ 1,000
