

RESOLUTION NO. 4192

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT ("HCD") FOR FY 2008-09 FOR A GENERAL ALLOCATION GRANT
UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ("CDBG") PROGRAM
TO FINANCE A HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM IN THE PROJECT AREA
IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$500,000**

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development is authorized to allocate General Allocation Grants under the Community Development Block Grant Program and has issued a Notice of Funding for FY 2008-09; and

WHEREAS, in response the City desires to submit an application for a General Allocation grant from the Community Development Block Grant Program to finance a Housing Rehabilitation Program for a maximum amount of \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City Council approve the submission of the application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council authorizes the City Manager to prepare and submit an application for a General Allocation grant from Community Development Block Grant Program for a maximum amount of \$500,000 for a Housing Rehabilitation Program.

Section 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary for the completion and submission of said grant application and any and all agreements and amendments necessary or required by the Department of Housing and Community Development.




