

**RESOLUTION NO. 4200**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
OPPOSING THE PLACEMENT OF THE RE-ENTRY FACILITY NEAR THE CITY OF  
SOLEDAD AND URGING THE MONTEREY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
TO REJECT THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA'S PROPOSAL TO CONSTRUCT A  
SECURE RE-ENTRY FACILITY NEAR THE CITY OF SOLEDAD**

**WHEREAS**, AB 900, the Public Safety and Offender Rehabilitation Services Act of 2007 authorizes the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation to partner with a participating county to enter into an agreement for the construction of a local jail facility; and

**WHEREAS**, The Monterey County Board of Supervisors along with Sheriff Mike Kanalakis have partnered with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and are proposing to construct a re-entry facility near the City of Soledad; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors is considering a site near the City of Soledad to be "the most suitable" location for the re-entry facility; and

**WHEREAS**, there is presently no information available to the City of Soledad on the negative impact of the proposed Re-entry facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Soledad is unaware of how the facility may offend or pose a safety risk to the Soledad community due to the close proximity of the proposed facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Soledad Opposes the placement of the Re-entry facility near the City of Soledad and Urging the Monterey County Board of Supervisors to put the safety of the City of Soledad community first, and reject the proposal of constructing a re-entry facility near the City of Soledad.


