

RESOLUTION NO. 4201

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A GANG TASK FORCE POSITION WITHIN
THE RANKS OF THE SOLEDAD POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE ASSIGNED TO
AND FUNDED BY THE MONTEREY COUNTY JOINT GANG TASK FORCE**

WHEREAS, the Soledad City Council desires to initiate a specific effort to address issues related to gang activity within the city limits of the City of Soledad; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad City Council authorizes the City Manager to create and implement (1) one additional sworn position within the ranks of the Police Department designated as a Soledad Gang Task Force Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Soledad Gang Task Force Officer will be assigned to the Monterey County Joint Gang Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the designated Soledad Gang Task Force position total compensation, overtime, and necessary safety equipment will be funded by the Monterey County Joint Task Force for a period of at least one year; and

WHEREAS, the designated Soledad Gang Task Force position total compensation, overtime, and necessary safety equipment may be funded by the City of Soledad after one year; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad hereby authorizes the City Manager to create (1) one additional sworn police position designated as the Soledad Gang Task Force Officer and assign that officer to the Monterey County Joint Gang Task Force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Soledad Police Department will assign (1) one full-time Police Officer to the Monterey County Joint Gang Task Force.


