

RESOLUTION NO. 4287

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2008-09
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PLANNING AND TECHNICAL
ASSISTANCE ALLOCATION UNDER THE GENERAL ALLOCATION COMPONENT
FOR AN UPDATE OF THE HOUSING ELEMENT IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$35,000
WITH A MINIMUM MATCH OF \$700 AND LEVERAGED FUNDING IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FROM PROGRAM INCOME**

WHEREAS, the State Department of Housing and Community Development issued a Notice of Funding for FY 2008-09; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application for a Planning and Technical Assistance Allocation (PTAA) grant from the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) under the General Allocation Component for the completion of an update of the Housing Element; and

WHEREAS, update of the Soledad Housing Element is required by State law to implement the updated Regional Housing Needs Allocation for the Region and the City; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the City will be required to provide a match of \$700 and the City would provide leveraged funding in the amount of \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City Council approve the submission of this grant application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows:

Section 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit an application for a grant from the Planning and Technical Assistance Allocation of the Community Development Block Grant Program under the General Allocation Component for completion of an update to the Housing Element in an amount not to exceed \$35,000 and a minimum match of \$700 and leveraged funding in the amount of \$15,000 from Program Income.

Section 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary for the completion and submission of said grant application and any and all amendments thereto.

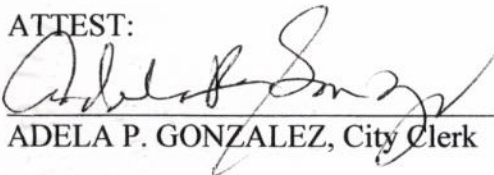

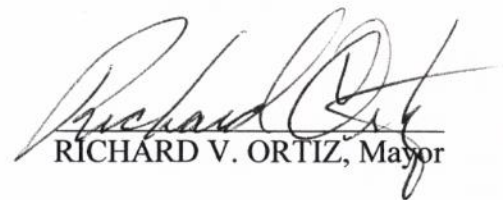
