

**RESOLUTION NO. 4295**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
APPROVING THE SOLEDAD POLICE DEPARTMENT'S  
PROPOSED SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT  
SERVICE FUNDS SPENDING PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-09**

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible for and anticipates receiving a \$100,000.00 grant from the Citizens Option for Public Safety Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Funds ("SLESF") Program for use for front-line law enforcement services, including anti-gang, community crime prevention and juvenile justice programs; and

**WHEREAS**, SLESF funding must be used to supplement rather than supplant existing services; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed plan for the use of SLESF funds must be pre-approved by the City Council and submitted to the Supplemental Law Enforcement Oversight Committee ("SLEOC") before such funds may be released to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the SLEOC has requested that cities provide the Committee with City Council approved spending plans by no later than September 17, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, based on specified funding requirements, Police Chief Richard A. Cox is recommending that \$100,000 of the 2008-2009 SLESF grant be used to fund the Investigator position and to pay for a part-time evidentiary technical services for a period of one year; and

**WHEREAS**, the investigator's position would continue to supplement the existing patrol force by providing detailed follow-up on serious crimes (burglaries, robberies and assaults) and assistance to the Monterey County Sheriff's department with major crime investigations by providing critical local support; and

**WHEREAS**, the evidence technical services will continue to include purging, organizing storage, establishing proper procedures for reporting, and recording of evidence and reviewing correspondence.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Council hereby approves the Police Chief's proposed plan for the use of the FY 2008-09 \$100,000.00 Supplemental Law Enforcement Service Grant to partially fund the police investigator's position for a period of one year and to fund evidentiary technical services, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and by this reference incorporated herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Council's approval, as set forth herein, is conditioned upon receipt of a SLESF \$100,000.00 grant during Fiscal Year 2008-09.


