

**RESOLUTION NO. 4350**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH  
THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND OTHER AGENCIES TO DESIGN AND  
IMPLEMENT A NEXT GENERATION RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM FOR  
MONTEREY COUNTY OPERATIONAL AREA EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, local governments across the country are obligated to meet federal mandates pertaining to the narrow banding of public safety and local government radio systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing public safety and local government radio systems in Monterey County are reaching the end of their useful life and are in need of renewal; and

**WHEREAS**, the update of the City's radio systems to enhance interoperability within the City and with other agencies is an important priority of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the regional Emergency Communications Users Advisory Council has taken a leadership role to facilitate a partnership amongst the public agencies in Monterey County to jointly procure a next generation radio system.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Manager is authorized to sign a multi-agency agreement enabling the City to participate in the procurement of the next generation radio system.




