

RESOLUTION NO. 4385

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NUMBER 1
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON FRONT STREET
AT OAK STREET FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$220,178.75**

WHEREAS, On June 3, 2009, the City Council awarded the contract to Don Chapin Company for the construction of a new traffic signal at the intersection of Front Street and Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to extend the right-turn lane so that the City can have full signal operation at the intersection and two-way access for the Soledad Tire Shop; and

WHEREAS, staff has obtained a proposal from Don Chapin Company to extend the right-turn lane; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the extended right-turn lane is \$220,178.75 and increases the contract to a total of \$618,655.75; and

WHEREAS, the City received a federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant in the amount of \$544,891 for this project and the additional funding required is \$73,764.75; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding in the amount of \$73,764.75 will come from either the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant or the Local Transportation Fund (LTF).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the Council hereby approves the Contract Change Order Number 1 for the Construction of Traffic Signal on Front Street at Oak Street for an amount of \$220,178.75 and authorizes the request for the additional funding of \$73,764.75 from the Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant. The Council also authorizes the expenditure of the available Local Transportation Fund (LTF) in the amount of \$73,764.75 if the request for the ARRA grant is unsuccessful.


