

RESOLUTION NO. 4399

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
SUPPORTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TARGETED EMPLOYMENT
AREA FOR THE SALINAS VALLEY ENTERPRISE ZONE**

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2009, the Salinas Valley Enterprise Zone received its final designation as an Enterprise Zone from the California Department of Housing and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Zones may designate census tracts located within the boundaries of cities and counties that have jurisdiction over an Enterprise Zone as a Targeted Employment Area, provided that at least 51% of the tract's residents are low- or moderate-income, using the most recent US Census Data; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Zone staff has determined that the following census tracts, as defined by the United States Department of Census, within the County of Monterey are eligible for inclusion in the Targeted Employment Area: 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 101.01, 102.01, 103.02, 104, 105.03, 105.04, 106.02, 108.01, 108.02, 111.01, 111.02, 112.01, 112.02, 113.01, 113.02, 114, and 115.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Soledad supporting the establishment of a Targeted Employment Area for the Salinas Valley Enterprise Zone within the census tracts identified above, subject to final approval by the California Department of Housing and Community Development.




