

**RESOLUTION NO. 4405\***

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
APPROVING THE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NUMBER 1 FOR  
THE CONSTRUCTION OF 2009 RESURFACING AND STRIPING PROJECT  
FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$101,264.40**

**WHEREAS**, On June 3, 2009, the City Council awarded the Construction of 2009 Resurfacing and Striping Project to California Pavement Maintenance Company for an amount of \$289,177.38; and

**WHEREAS**, On December 19, 2008, the City received Proposition 1B funds, which are to be used street related work such as street resurfacing, repair or street construction, in the amount of \$421,624.33; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff also found that the damaged pavement on Kidder Street and Nestles Road need immediate repair to prevent further damages; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed seal coat at the City Hall parking lot would not seal the existing cracks and needs an overlay; and

**WHEREAS**, the contractor agreed to perform additional pavement repair at the bid unit costs for a total of \$87,278.40; and

**WHEREAS**, for the overlay of the parking lot, the contractor agreed to perform the overlay for a lump sum of \$13,986.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Soledad that:

1. The Council hereby Approves the Contract Change Order number 1 for the Construction of 2009 Resurfacing and Striping Project for an amount of \$101,264.40, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Contract Change Order number 1.


