

RESOLUTION NO. 4426

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING THE SOLEDAD POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PROPOSED
SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE FUNDS SPENDING PLAN FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2009-10**

WHEREAS, the City is eligible for and anticipates receiving a \$100,000.00 grant from the Citizens Option for Public Safety Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Funds ("SLESF") Program for use for front-line law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, SLESF funding must be used to supplement rather than supplant existing services; and

WHEREAS, the proposed plan for the use of SLESF funds must be pre-approved by the City Council and submitted to the Supplemental Law Enforcement Oversight Committee ("SLEOC") before such funds may be released to the City; and

WHEREAS, the SLEOC has requested that cities provide the Committee with City Council approved spending plans by no later than October 7, 2009; and

WHEREAS, based on specified funding requirements, the Police Chief is recommending that \$100,000 of the 2009-2010 SLESF grant be used to fund partial payment for a peace officer position and to pay for police officer training needs; and

WHEREAS, the peace officer position would continue staffing the complement of officers authorized on the existing patrol force; and

WHEREAS, The training needs of the Department will be met as required by the Police Officers Standard and Training.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the City Council hereby approves the Police Chief's proposed plan for the use of the FY 2009-2010 \$100,000.00 Supplemental Law Enforcement Service Grant to partially fund a peace officer's position for a period of one year and to fund training needs, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and by this reference incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council's approval, as set forth herein, is conditioned upon receipt of a SLESF \$100,000.00 grant during Fiscal Year 2009-10.



The credit shall be equivalent to the percentage of the total RDIF project costs shown in Exhibit A for which there is overlap in each participating jurisdiction.
