

RESOLUTION NO. 5086

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
DECLARING AN END TO THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS EMERGENCY
THREATENING LIFE, HEALTH AND PROPERTY AND RETROACTIVELY
APPROVING ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,685.24**

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2015, three water main leaks developed within the City's water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2015, a quorum of City Council was convened at a special meeting and thereafter adopted Resolution No. 5062, which declared an emergency pursuant to Section 20168 of the Public Contract Code and Section 3.24.040 of the Soledad Municipal Code, authorized staff to dispense with typical bidding requirements in order to facilitate the retention of contractors and/or consultants necessary to respond to the need for emergency repairs, and approved an initial expenditure of \$50,000 from the City's Water Operations Fund to pay for such repairs; and

WHEREAS, staff retained Monterey Peninsula Engineering to assist with the required repairs, Harris & Associated for design and construction inspections, and Ferguson Waterworks for parts; and

WHEREAS, staff had initially estimated that \$50,000 would be necessary to repair the above-referenced damaged water mains; and

WHEREAS, additional expenses of \$17,685.24 were necessary for the repair of all three water main leaks, bringing up the total cost to a total of \$67,685.24.

WHEREAS, the three water leaks have now been repaired and the emergency declaration of February 18, 2015 can be terminated.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Soledad that the emergency declared by Resolution No. 5062 of February 18, 2015, has now ceased.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby retroactively authorizes an additional expense of \$17,685.24 for the involved water main repairs. Funds for said expense shall be drawn from the Water Operations Fund.


