

**RESOLUTION NO. 5255**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD  
DECLARING SURPLUS EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE, DONATION,  
OR DISPOSAL OF OUTDATED AND OBSOLETE POLICE UNIFORMS AND  
UNIFORM EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Government State Code Section 37350 - 37351 provides for the ability of cities to dispose of property for the common benefit of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Soledad Police Department has accumulated uniforms, boots and cold weather jackets that are either obsolete, outdated or no longer of use to the City of Soledad and the Police Department and thus are considered surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, the value, obsolescence and condition of these items make it impractical to trade the same in on future purchases of new inventory items, and to obtain maximum return for said surplus items, and as such, it is in the best interest of the City to sell, donate or dispose of the same; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Soledad has in the past declared obsolete, outdated or property no longer of use to the City as surplus property and authorized that the property be sold, destroyed or donated to other agencies for use; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff has compiled a list of surplus equipment and is recommending that the City Council declare it as surplus and direct staff to donate the uniforms and equipment to the Nation of Mexico and their police departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows:

1. Based upon the findings and recommendations of City Staff, the items of inventory belonging to said City as shown in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto, are declared surplus.
2. That it is deemed to be for the common benefit of the residents of said City to dispose of said inventory by sale, donation or other appropriate means.
