

RESOLUTION NO. 5289

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING A PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH YAMABE &
HORN ENGINEERING, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$42,500 FOR CIVIL
ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PAVEMENT
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (PMP).**

WHEREAS, with recent passing of Measure X, TAMC is requiring participating agencies to develop a software based Pavement Management Program (PMP) that will be used to inventory, assign a pavement condition index (PCI) number, and determine the best ways to spend funds generated by Measure X on road maintenance and rehabilitation projects; and

WHEREAS, although Soledad requested and has obtained specific language within the Measure that allows use of Measure X funds for new construction, maintenance of existing roads is also possible with Measure X funds and the City is in need of a program to assure our high Pavement Management Index (PMI) remains as high as possible; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project has an expedited and strict timeline requirement necessitating that the project be designed, bid and constructed by March 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2016, Council authorized a two year agreement extension with Yamabe & Horn Engineering for on-call engineering services such as this project; and

WHEREAS, Yamabe & Horn Engineering, Inc., as the Engineer of Record for this project is well qualified oversee the construction process and general contract administration; and

WHEREAS, the total anticipated cost of requisite professional services is \$42,500 as outlined in the attached Yamabe and Horn Proposal; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is available in the adopted Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget for Transportation Impact Fee Funds; and

WHEREAS, after requesting and reviewing the Yamabe and Horn proposal, staff has determined that it is reasonable, and therefore Staff is recommending that Council award this Pavement Management Program Task Order to them.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad that "A Proposal for Professional Services with Yamabe & Horn Engineering, Inc., to Provide Civil Engineering Services for the Development of the Pavement Management Program," a copy of which is attached hereto marked as **Exhibit A**, and by this reference incorporated herein, is hereby approved.







Pursuant to your request, we are pleased to submit this proposal for the subject project. Yamabe & Horn will perform the following task:

Task 1: Software/Setup \$7,500

Yamabe & Horn will acquire, on the City's behalf, and set up the latest version of Street Saver – the industry standard for municipal pavement management programs.

Task 2: Data/GIS Integration of Existing Surveys \$13,000

Yamabe & Horn coordinate and integrate current GIS models of the City along with the existing Street Survey Data that was previously collected into Street Saver.

Task 3: Upgrade System with Completed Projects/Run Scenarios \$9,500

Yamabe & Horn will upgrade the system with completed projects since the collection of the original data providing the most current ratings of the roadways. We will then run various scenarios to determine potential maintenance projects to complete.

Task 4: Field Verify/New Surveys \$12,500

Yamabe & Horn will perform field surveys to verify current conditions with the projected conditions of the computer software and complete new surveys as necessary.

The tasks as specified above will be performed on a Time and Material (T&M) basis, based on the agreed Fee Schedule, not to exceed \$42,500. We will let the City know and submit subsequent expansion letter if additional fee is needed to perform work as described above or beyond.
