

RESOLUTION NO. 5338

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLEDAD
APPROVING A CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER WITH SURVEILLANCEGRID
INTEGRATIONS, INC. FOR PHASE IV OF THE LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION
AND SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED
\$105,249.67**

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2016, Council awarded a contract to SurveillanceGRID Integrations, Inc. for Phase III of the License Plate Recognition and Surveillance System Project; and

WHEREAS, additional Phases are necessary to provide Video Surveillance and recording at the remaining City ingress/egress points and City facilities as several have had significant vandalism and theft and are continually at risk and need video surveillance as a theft and vandalism deterrent and prosecution tool; and

WHEREAS, Phase IV of the project will include the installation of surveillance equipment at the Soledad Community Center (YMCA), adding cameras at the Building and Utilities counters inside City Hall, Santana Park, Nestles to southbound on-ramp to 101, Metz Road ingress/egress to the City, Vosti Park and transmitter system expansion, and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the purchase and installation of the additional License Plate Recognition and Surveillance System equipment to be located as proposed; and

WHEREAS, while the purchase and installation of such equipment would normally be subject to the procedures set forth in Soledad Municipal Code Chapter 3.24, the purchase of surveillance equipment from another vendor, and the subsequent connection of such equipment to the City's existing surveillance system, raises significant potential problems associated with incompatibility in use and maintenance, and as such, the Council has determined that the "sole source" exception from usual bidding and purchase procedures set forth in Section 3.24.040A.(3) of the Code can be utilized for this particular purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Soledad as follows;

1. All of the recitals set forth above are true and correct to the best of its knowledge and by this reference, are incorporated herein.
2. That the Council hereby approves and authorizes a Contract Change Order with SurveillanceGRID Integrations, Inc. for Phase IV of the License Plate Recognition and Surveillance System Project in an Amount not to exceed \$105,249.67, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, and incorporated herein by this reference.



TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOLEDAD AND SURVEILLANCEGRID INTEGRATION, INC. FOR THE LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION AND SURVEILLANCE PROJECT PHASE IV

WHEREAS, the City of Soledad, a municipal corporation of the State of California entered into an agreement dated October 5, 2106 with SurveillanceGrid Integration, Inc., for a total price of \$83,519.75 for the Soledad License Plate Recognition and Surveillance Project Phase III.

1. REASON FOR CHANGE.

Additional Phases are necessary to provide Video Surveillance and recording at the remaining City ingress/egress points and City facilities as several have had significant vandalism and theft and are continually at risk and need video surveillance as a theft and vandalism deterrent and prosecution tool. Phase IV of the project will include the installation of surveillance equipment at the Soledad Community Center (YMCA), adding cameras at the Building and Utilities counters inside City Hall, Santana Park, Nestles to southbound on-ramp to 101, Metz Road ingress/egress to the City, Vosti Park and transmitter system expansion.
